Our light and spacious lounge is a real pleasure. Tastefully furnished ,with Parker Knoll wing chairs and a baby grand piano, it overlooks the garden on 2 sides.



The lounge is complemented by a dining room where each resident enjoys a separate table with white linen and fine tableware. All meals are served by our friendly, experienced waitresses.

A south facing patio area overlooking the lawn and established garden makes a lovely location to enjoy morning coffee and afternoon tea on warmer days.

Your personal bedroom and living area with ensuite bathroom

All bedrooms have private en-suite bathrooms are well appointed and are on the ground and first floor only (first floor rooms are serviced by easily negotiated stairs or a passenger lift which moves you effortlessly between the two floors ensuring stairs are not a problem should you prefer a first floor room).

Briar Dene is fully centrally heated ensuring your bedroom is a warm and cosy place in which to relax.

Each room and en-suite bathroom is equipped with an emergency call system. Therefore, if you require assistance (or just a cup of tea ...) at any time day or night, our care staff are just a moment away.

Our housekeeping staff will ensure that your room is cleaned every morning and your clothing laundered as necessary.

Residents are of course welcome to bring items of furniture and personal effects which will be treated with the utmost care and respect.

A real home from home

At Briar Dene we aim to make you feel relaxed and welcome, a home from home. We do the following to help promote this:

- Residents are encouraged to maintain their independence;
- You are addressed in the manner of your choosing;
- Your religious, cultural and personal preferences are respected;
- Outings are arranged periodically for your enjoyment;
- Activities are organised a number of afternoons each week, such as quizzes, bingo and gentle exercises;
- Coffee mornings are held in the lounge or garden in aid of local charities; and
- Transport can be arranged to local shops and amenities which are but a short distance away.

We respect your personal feelings

Individual personal care such as assistance with bathing and dressing is an integral part of our service and this is always given with the utmost regard and respect for the personal feelings of the resident.

Our experienced, well trained and carefully chosen team of staff members will ensure the highest standard of care for all. Staff will discharge their duties to a high standard ensuring privacy, dignity, independence and choice.

In addition to the above functions carried out by staff at the home, we receive regular visits from a chiropodist and two hairdressers. General Practitioners, district nurses and other health care professionals make regular visits thus ensuring that all your needs are catered for.



A summary of the service we provide:

Care

A resident's care needs will be assessed prior to arriving with us and fully documented on arrival and updated regularly thereafter. This will ensure that our dedicated team of care staff can meet all your care needs, from assisting with washing/dressing/bathing where required to dispensing medication properly.

For those residents who are not as steady on their feet as they once were, our care staff will assist you when moving around the building, to/from the bathroom and generally as required.

If care staff believe that a resident requires additional medical attention, they will liaise with your GP as necessary.

At least 2 care staff are on duty 24 hours a day to assist residents and for their peace of mind.

Housekeeping

Our housekeepers will make beds and clean bedrooms daily to the highest standard as well as maintaining our high standards in the rest of the home.

Laundry

All personal clothing will be laundered in-house and returned to your wardrobe fully pressed.

Meals and Refreshments

All meals and refreshments are included and during a day typically consists of:
Breakfast: a varied, nutritional choice is available. Some residents choose to have their breakfast served in their room.

Morning Tea: Tea or coffee, biscuits

Lunch: main meal of the day - freshly prepared soup starter, main course prepared from fresh produce (meat, poultry, fish, vegetables etc), freshly prepared/baked dessert.

Afternoon: Tea or coffee, biscuits

Tea: a lighter meal (eg freshly prepared quiche, sandwiches, eggs) together with a freshly baked cake.

Supper: a hot drink with a snack of tealoaf, malt loaf or biscuit.
